

GENERAL BUSINESS MINOR

The Ivy College of Business offers a structured minor in general business to students outside the college. The minor requires a minimum of 15 credits and must include at least 6 credits in courses numbered 300 or above taken at Iowa State University. A “C” average or better is required in courses used to satisfy the minor requirements. All prerequisites for minor courses must be met prior to taking the course. All minor courses must be taken for a grade. Students with declared majors have priority over students with declared minors in courses with space constraints.

GBUS minor students needing more courses to meet the “nine credit stand alone” rule will need to apply to the Ivy College of Business for an exception, or should consider taking one additional course of ACCT 285, ACCT 215, or BUSAD 250.
